Marshal Briefing:

Thank you very much for volunteering to marshal at the Walk. Without you the event could not go ahead.

Please be at The Daten at 10am for a full briefing to find out your location & timing. Marshals will be stationed at the main junctions and road crossings.

Your job will be to direct the walkers, but you are not permitted to stop traffic.

You will be given a rubbish bag to collect any litter from the walkers and return to The Daten.

The Route:

As shown overleaf – it will be marked with mile markers and arrows tied to lampposts and WaterAid balloons.

If you have a problem at any time, ring **07899 652643**. We have First Aid cover that can come out to you, and/or we can collect walkers who need to be rescued.

Please ring the same number to let us know when the last walker has passed you.

The walkers are all challenging themselves – they will really appreciate a smile & oo encouraging words

The Event:

We are expecting around 40 walkers to set off from The Daten Car Park at 11am.

Parking:

In The Daten Car Park.
Clamping is in operation in some parts of Culcheth centre – beware!

Facilities:

Toilets & changing facilities are available for you and the walkers.

Toilets are at Bents (2.5 miles) and St Catherines Church (6 miles), as well as at The Daten (start and finish.)


Refreshments:
